SUNDAY NIGHTS All high school aged teens are welcome to come to the Youth Room from 7:00-8:45PM on Sunday nights. We gather together to meet with friends, share our faith, and discuss topics relevant to your life.

TEEN MASS The JR High and High School youth are invited to celebrate the Eucharist together on the second Sunday of the month at the 5:30 Mass. It is a great chance to gather with your peers and show the congregation the awesome and vibrant faith of our teens. Get involved as a lector, usher, altar server, member of the choir, or just be present to each other in the congregation.

WORK CAMP Help those in need while having fun in a new part of the country. This faith filled week is spent painting and repairing homes in a needy community. An information meeting will be held in **September**. Space is limited. Watch the bulletin for details.

PEER MENTORING This is a new program we are working to develop. It would be a monthly gathering for fellowship (food, games, and faith formation) with teens with special needs.

RETREATS There are two retreats a year (dates and locations TBA). They are weekends specifically designed to meet you where you are on your faith journey in a fun and non-threatening way. Learn more about yourself, your faith, and your friends.

LITURGICAL MINISTRY Do you enjoy attending Mass? Maybe you are looking for a way to get more out of it. Try one of the Liturgical Ministries. You could usher, lector, sing in a choir, or help plan the liturgy (where do you think the Prayers of the Faithful come from?). You do not have to commit to weekly service to serve!

SMALL GROUP FORMATION Maybe coming to Night Life is not your thing, or you just don't have time Sunday night, but you still want the chance to explore your faith and share it with friends. Small group formation is a great way for this to take place. Meeting times and location would be determined by the group's needs and availability. It could be Seasonal (Lent/Advent) or year long. Bible Study, Guided Reflection, Prayer Group, etc. or based on special talents and interests (knitting, art, cooking, running, you name it!)
