What is your child being taught?

What's in the Family Life Education (FLE) curriculum?

- ✧ Fourth and fifth grade videos depict fathers as abusive.
- ✧ Some FLE lessons confuse children by imposing gender ideology in place of biology.
- ✧ An eighth grade exercise on abstinence prompts students to include reasons for not being abstinent.
- ✧ Many FLE lessons on sensitive topics include a "Home Connection" letter that students take home after a lesson has been taught - too late for parents to opt their children out.
- ✧ Many FLE lessons include "shoulder partner" exercises in which students randomly pair with others to discuss highly personal and potentially embarrassing information.
- ✧ Many FLE lessons normalize practices that medical science characterizes as seriously hazardous to physical health.
