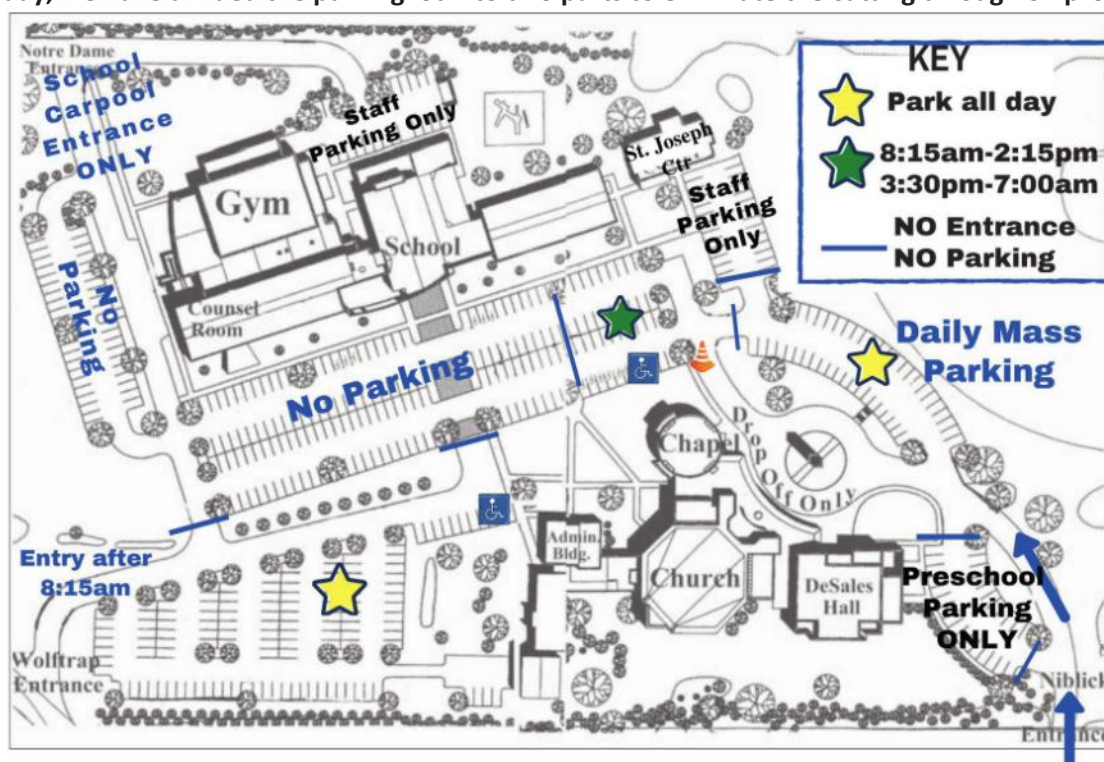

Monday - Friday, we have divided the parking lot into two parts to eliminate the cutting through on property.



New OLGC Outreach Plan: Fr. PAYING FOR ASSISTED LIVING – It's wise to know your options when paying for care. When considering potential assisted living communities, it's important to research your payment options. Although Medicare doesn't cover the costs of assisted living, there are a variety of payment sources available. The National Center for Assisted Living reports that "certain services are paid under Supplementary Security Income and Social Services Block Grant Programs." Individuals who meet income qualifications may also be eligible for assistance through their state Medicaid program. Some communities also offer internal financial assistance programs. State and local governments may offer subsidies for rent to those who are income-eligible. Contact the local Area Agency on Aging for more information on subsidies and other payment assistance programs.

Long-term care insurance policies provide another financing option for assisted living. Most of these policies will cover the costs of assisted living. Some of these are also reimbursable through individual health insurance policies. While there are other payment options available, the vast majority of assisted living/personal care costs are covered through private payments by residents and families; individuals should investigate all available payment sources and obtain specific information on

standard rates and fees for additional services before choosing an assisted living community. Financial and insurance experts can provide more detailed information about all the available payment sources. (Thanks to Sourcebook.)

To make your research easier, I want to repeat the contact information for the Sourcebook, which appeared here in May of last year. It's a free magazine that comes in the mail. You can research it online by visiting www.retirementlivingsourcebook.com or call 800-394-9990 to request a copy. Be sure to ask for the Metro Washington, DC edition. It'll take 10-14 days to get to you. Hands down, this is the best resource for searching out every possible senior living option in the area. It also has articles of interest pertaining to each option, plenty of picture ads, and complete contact information for each residence or facility, listed by county. You'll find it to be the easiest, most convenient way to learn about senior housing in all of its forms. I highly recommend it.
