INOVA Health Clinics & Home Health Care: Working closely with our Partnership for Healthier Communities colleagues, INOVA assists patients who qualify for Medicaid with the enrollment application process. For patients who do not



qualify for Medicaid, we will explore the possibility of charity care with the patient. Health providers will see anyone (Virginia residents) regardless of immigration status and are geared to serving the Medicaid and uninsured population. Inova has a very generous financial aid program that grants families or individuals who are 400% or below FPL care at no cost (this includes labs, most specialty care, and imaging) if they complete the application process. INOVA participates with all Virginia Medicaid plans. Clinics are staffed with internists, family doctors, pediatricians, nurses, etc., so they can care for everybody. The Inova Medical House Calls Program brings primary care to homebound patients who are 65 years of age or greater. The goal is to provide quality care while supporting aging in place and optimizing resource utilization. INOVA healthcare team of doctors, nurse practitioners, and social workers will provide comprehensive care for patients who have difficulty leaving the home and coordinate patients' health and wellness programs. Inova Medical House Calls is tailored specifically for patients who are 65 years of age or older, have difficulty leaving home for medical appointments, have Medicare, Medicaid or other health insurance that will pay for homebound care.
