**The past two months OLGC has shown with action how to Live Jesus.** Every month even through this pandemic, our parishioners continued to make breakfast and lunch for The Lamb Center, bring dinner to Christ House, and bring breakfast to SOME. We provided food assistance to approximately 3,000 people over the last 4 months. Because CHO had not been accepting food donations, OLGC provided CHO with \$1,250 worth of Giant food cards. We refer anyone with financial need to OLGC's Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) as they have a full team of volunteers and resources. SVdP provided emergency assistance (money for rent or utilities) to approximately 62 families each month. Additionally OLGC parishioners donated approximately 14,262 diapers, 14,263 wipes, 20 tubes of diaper rash ointment, 11 containers of formula, 2 packages of pull-ups, and \$1,685 in cash & gift cards were collected.

MY WORLD DURING THE PANDEMIC cont'd – I've gotten a lot of questions from friends who wonder what life is like in a retirement community as we wait out the long months of COVID 19. Last week you read about all of the restrictions we observed. The most difficult part was learning to adapt to self-isolation. Socialization is a big part of life here, and suddenly everything stopped. Extremely comforting was knowing there was an emergency plan in place that had been successfully used before, under different circumstances. We learned of it from the Medical Director here early in March at a Town Hall meeting. Paramount was deep gratitude for not having to experience this in my former house, alone. Many of us still maintain our independence, and having so many services provided, made us feel pampered! Confidence took on a new meaning knowing there was an army outside our door should we need help.

The human spirit in adversity is amazing! Adversity brings with it opportunity and fosters creativity. Giving of self has blossomed here. A couple in the next building are musicians and a few times they played hour-long concerts from their balcony. Everyone living around the courtyard was able to hear them. On my corridor, we celebrated six birthdays, passed cupcakes, and sang from our doorways. Sometimes there was wine!

The Resident Life staff surprised us with small gifts and cards on our package shelves outside our doors on every holiday. Once a cocktail cart rolled through, which ended up in a party with my neighbors, all of us sitting on chairs in the hallway, six feet apart, laughing and talking. Residents shared their travel films and other interesting presentations on our in-house TV station. Also featured there were daily exercises, movies, and a program of "oldies but goodies" from another resident's collection. We also had each other, knowing we were surrounded by good people who have become like family. The feeling of security is priceless.

The majority of my days have been full. St. Francis de Sales' advice to "live in the moment:" has been a guiding light. Life for all of us, I think, will be forever changed, and while we don't know what the "new normal" will look like, we must move forward with hope and gratitude.
