# Choosing a Confirmation Name Pray | Research | Reflect

- This saint is your spiritual companion
- Could be your baptismal name (if baptized with a saint's name)
- Could be a saint that is special to you or your family
- Could be a saint that shares a special day with you
  - i.e. your birthday is on their feast day
- Could be a saint that is a patron of one of your hobbies, interests, etc.
- Must choose a Saint or a Blessed recognized by the Catholic Church
- Ask your mom, dad, sponsor, sibling, grandparent, godparent, etc. which saint they chose and why to help give you ideas
- Take this choice to prayer and see which saint God reveals to you
- Document in the packet of materials with resources to help you research



# Choosing a Sponsor

- Select one person to journey and support you as you prepare for Confirmation and beyond
- Like a coach or teacher
  - ❖ Want to select someone who knows the game, but in our case knows the faith.
  - This person has the experience to guide you in deepening your relationship with Jesus and witnesses to you and to others God's love for the world.
- Could be one of your godparents
- See the packet for the document on Choosing a Confirmation Sponsor
- The sponsor should be present to stand with you as you are confirmed.




# Qualifications of a Sponsor

- Someone who is at least 16 years old
- Someone who is not your (the Confirmation candidate's) parent
- Someone who has received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist)
- Someone who is a committed and active Roman Catholic, committed to living his or her life in accord with Catholic Church Teaching and Tradition and fully participates in the sacramental life of the Church
- ❖ If married, someone whose marriage is recognized by the Catholic Church
- **\*** This person must provide a Letter of Good Standing / Sponsor Eligibility Form.
  - This letter/form/certificate comes from the sponsor's home parish stating that he/she meets the qualifications above. Sponsors from OLGC also need to submit one.
  - This form is due to Amy W. de Bernardo by August 1, 2022.

# Role of Parents

- Pray for your child during this time
- Power of Witness (Prayer, Mass, sacraments, etc.)
- Engage your child in the Confirmation formation and preparation and in conversations about the faith-you are the primary educators!
- Continue your own formation:
  - Salesian Presentations
  - ❖ Bulletin, Website, and weekly OLGC email newsletters
  - Formed.org (can sign up for free under OLGC's account)
- ❖ 7<sup>th</sup> graders- don't be afraid to ask questions to your parents, sponsors, catechists/teachers, etc. Preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation is an important step in your life- Explore it!

  - Physical certificate due March 1, 2022 to Amy W. de Bernardo at OLGC
  - We only need this if the Confirmation Candidate was NOT baptized at OLGC.
- Confirmation Retreat Registration and Completion Opens May 1, 22
  - Online Form (will be emailed and posted online)
- Form 2A. Confirmation Name (Saint) & Sponsor Info Due June 1, 2022
  - Online Form (will be emailed and posted online)
- **Letter of Good Standing / Sponsor Eligibility Form-** Due Aug. 1, 2022
  - Original copy needs to be sent to Amy de Bernardo at OLGC
