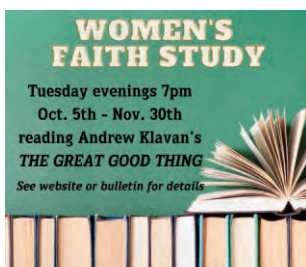

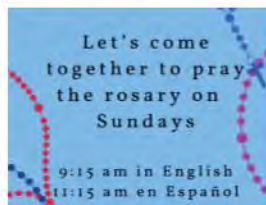

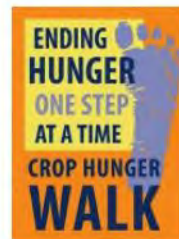

# Community & Diocesan Updates



**Laudato Si:** The urgent challenge to protect our common home includes a concern to bring the whole human family together to seek a sustainable and integral development, for we know that things can change. 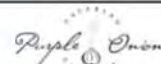
