### Vacation Bible School: July 11 - July 15th, 9am - 12 pm Register by Sun. June 26th!


This year's theme is "Monumental: Celebrating God's Greatness."



My dad has been gone for 41 years, and I'd give anything to be able to sit down with him and just talk. He was one of those quiet types who didn't say much, but when he did, it counted. He had an enormous influence in my life and even in the lives of my children – values they carry to this day. Let's remember them all today and give thanks. WHAT WOULD JESUS DO IN OLD AGE? Cont'd. - "If Jesus had joined us for breakfast, he would have joined us in talking about memory lapses – Why did I walk into this room? – and about a close friend who died a couple of years ago and about a grandchild and about someone we know who's grieving over the death of a sibling. He would have taken part in our discussion of trying to figure out how to relate to our adult children who, to our great surprise, have lives that don't have us at the center. And Jesus would have joined with us in bemoaning our aches and pains and health worries and limitations. And he would have had his share. He was human, after all. Actually, if Jesus had gotten to 75, he'd be doing just about the same sort of stuff we're doing. Like the two of us, he'd be talking regularly with doctors who'd be so much younger that they'd seem like teenagers. And he'd be finding ways to fill his time while the rest of the world went about its busy business. And he'd be hanging around with and talking on the phone to and going to wakes and funerals for other old codgers.

What would Jesus do? He would have the same sort of life that we're living. He would be. Simply be. Instead of ministering to huge crowds and traipsing long miles on dusty roads, he'd be ministering to guys like us, like him. By simply being there.

He would minister by being Christlike. That is, by really listening to the other old guys who aren't looking for answers so much as they are for someone to hear them. He would be honest about what he was feeling at such an advanced age. If he was troubled in spirit, he'd be honest about it and not try to pretend that everything was hunkydory. When you get to be our age, nothing's all that hunkydory.

He would visit the sick if it wasn't too depressing for him, or too traumatic. He would accept the humility that age had forced on him – unless this was one of those times when he was angry about it. He would take each moment as the gift it is, and each person, too. And reflect that to everyone around him. So, that's how we've decided to act. We're going to be like Christ.


