5 THINGS – In the May issue of the AARP Bulletin, there's an excellent article about how to be a good executor. There's lots of good information there for people who have been named executors of someone's estate, which I hope to explore sometime in the future (when we have more space), but the highlight Is "5 Things to Tell *YOUR* Executor." Here we go:

Where the original will is. Identify the exact spot in your home. If it's filed with an attorney, provide the contact information. If it's stored online, specify the website. DON'T put it in a safe deposit box where it can be difficult to access after your death.

<u>Whom to notify.</u> List people your executor or family might not think to tell or know how to reach, such as doctors, your employer's HR chief if you're still working, clubs you belong to. Include contact information to make things easier for the person delegated this task.

Your passwords. Share passwords and access codes for e-mail, social media, other online accounts, and any cellphones or computers. Provide instructions about how to handle the accounts and devices. Don't want your executor to be able to access all this while you're alive? Give the passwords to someone else you trust.

Who gets what. Specify what happens to nonfinancial

items such as recipes, photos, and mementos.

Think about the things in your life that are special to you, that tell a little about you to future generations.

Where your secrets are hidden. Point the executor, or another trustworthy person, to any skeletons you want to be cleaned from your closets, such as love letters from an ex, compromising photos, and medicine you may have

been covertly taking.

OPEN TO VISITORS – Nursing homes have opened up to visitors! The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services loosened the rules for visiting nursing home residents indoors. Guests can visit residents indoors, regardless of vaccine status. The resident also doesn't need to be vaccinated for an indoor visit, according to the nonbinding guidance. But indoor visits to unvaccinated residents should be limited if the county's COVID-19's positivity rate is more than 10% and if less than 70% of the facility's residents are unvaccinated. Outdoor visits are still preferred. (Kiplinger's Retirement Report, May 2021)






