



WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS, ELDERLY – In a statement, Bishop Burbidge wrote: "Sunday, July 25, we observe the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, established by Pope Francis to be held on the fourth Sunday of July every year. Pope Francis tells us, 'The elderly remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between the different generations, to pass on to the young the experience of life.' So may we mark this day on our calendars this year and every year. I encourage you to call or visit your grandparents sometime during this week if they are living, pray for them if they are deceased, or offer to help an elderly neighbor. They have wisdom to share, and we should extend our respect for their experience and their God-given dignity."

NEW GUIDELINES FOR STAMP DONATIONS – Due to a change in how outreach projects/collections are being conducted at OLGC, <u>used and new stamps and other</u> <u>philatelic items are no longer accepted in the</u> <u>Administration Building and the Welcome Desk in the</u> <u>Narthex.</u> Our outreach projects are for designated local charities and occur every month. However, this doesn't mean you can't continue to participate in the stamp

program. You can send your postal items directly to the Sisters of Notre Dame, Stamp Ministry, 100 Augusta Hall-Saint Mary's, Notre Dame, IN 46556. They're especially interested in stamp albums. If you have any to donate, send only the pages; don't remove the stamps. You can also send canceled stamps and small postal items to me: Marge Van Lierde, 44715 Audubon Sq., #307, Ashburn, VA 20147, or you can bring them with you to the Seasoned Citizens luncheons. Collect only commemorative and highvalue, and foreign stamps. Those showing the American flag, "USA," an eagle, fruit, or stars are plentiful and have no resale value. Philatelic items such as first-day covers, stamp dedication programs, mint stamp blocks, and sheets are highly desirable. The Sisters' Stamp Ministry uses the funds generated from the sale of these postal items to fund their missionary work around the world. I'm grateful for the ever-increasing number of parishioners who have contributed to the annual stamp drive for more than 15 years and hope you'll continue to help.
