



COVID TEST KIT EXPIRATION DATES — If you have these home test kits, you may not have noticed that they have an expiration date. If you check the box, you'll see the date, which could be very soon. But don't throw it away before you take a look at the expiration extensions posted online. Go to: https://www.fda.gov/medical-devices/coronavirus-covid-19-and-medical-devices/home-otc-covid-19-diagnostic-tests#list. Here you'll see how to check the manufacturer of your particular test and learn what the latest expiration update is. My understanding is that they check every three months and if the research shows the tests are still usable for a longer period of time, the information will be updated. Thanks to a parishioner who provided this helpful information.

New schedules for Fall activities are already being distributed, and before we know it, we'll be hearing Christmas carols at the mall! Before that begins to happen, I hope you'll be able to participate in some of the activities that are listed here, and live life the best you can during these last weeks of summer.

BIG SCREEN ON THE GREEN – The next (and last) free movie of the season, "Soul", on the Vienna Town Green, will be Thursday, August 11 at 8:30 pm. The storyline is about Joe, who is a middle-school band teacher whose life hasn't gone the way he expected. His true passion is jazz – and he's good! But when he travels to another realm to help someone find their passion, he soon discovers what it means to have soul. Bring blankets or folding chairs; no alcohol, and please leave your pets at home.

NEW TRIP – Vienna Parks and Recreation has planned a lovely outing to historic Culpeper, Virginia, on September 14 from 9 am-5:30 pm. You'll take a deep dive into the growth of this small town from the beginning of the 20th century with its changing people, places, and structures. A docent will lead a tour of the Culpeper Museum and you'll also enjoy a walking tour along one of Culpeper's oldest and most picturesque streets with homes dating back to 1831! Also included in your stops will be a tour of the rolling hills to the Brandy Station Battlefield, which still

retains much of its wartime character as the location of the largest cavalry battle in the United States. Lunch will be on your own at Thyme in Culpeper. You can call or stop by the Administration Office or click on the link in the most recent weekly Bulletin: I've been using this system to make my Sunday and Holy Day donations for many years and there's never been an error.

We expect our Pastor and the Finance Council to be good stewards of these funds. Just like us, they depend on this income the same way we count on getting our Social Security or retirement pension funds in a timely fashion each month so we can pay our bills. Electronic giving was critical during the pandemic - it kept our contributions coming even though many of us were unable to attend Mass for many months. about 8 am, you'll receive an e-mail showing you images of what's going to be delivered that day. If you're expecting important documents, maybe a check or a package, it's great to know that it'll be in your mailbox in a few hours.


