## **Liturgy & Worship**

- Working Sound System in the Church Underway and continues into the fall with target by Advent
- Conduct a Parish Survey regarding Parish Life and Worship Delayed, pending census
- Conduct a Monthly Youth Mass Completed in FY 18 continues in future
- Targeted recruitment of School & CCF parents for Liturgical Ministries Continues, building on Altar Server connections
- Discern, Evaluate and Grow the Music Ministry of OLGC Completed in FY 18, continues with improvements in future
- Use of Website for Additional and Higher -Quality Catechesis Delayed, pending hiring of Communications Director
- Establish Devotional Candles Continues into Fall with placement in Chapel planned
- Form a Ministry of Hospitality Greeters Recruitment beginning in Fall
- Communion to Sick and Homebound *Ministers dismissed from Daily Mass and Sunday, Three of Four Visit Types are underway; Development of "Stephens" type visit Next Year*
- Renovate/ Refurbish/ Remodel/ Renew our Parish Worship Facilities *Candlesticks and other liturgical items have been completed. Furniture and piano delivered in late fall.*
- Feasibility Study Forming a Children's Choir *Delayed, pending further review.*
- Reorganize the Ushers into ministry mode as opposed to organization/club mode Beginning in Fall

- Incorporate Salesian Spirituality throughout Faith Formation **Between Monthly Salesian Talks and the DeSales Book Club** there were multiple opportunities to experience Salesian Spirituality Continues and improves in future
- Conduct OLGC Parish Wide Service Events We were not able to plan this for this year since the weather wasn't in our
  favor in Advent, but we have been emailing the CCF families regarding service opportunities at OLGC. Try again next
  year.
- Establish a Youth Mass (working with Liturgy and Worship Mission) Completed in FY 18, continues in future
- Increase Promotion of Faith Formation Opportunities Delayed pending hiring of Communications Director.
- Place Student Representatives on Youth Board for Hispanic, Fil Am communities Completed in FY 18, continues in future
- Establish Preschool Family Faith Mixer Cross Mission Activity with School Completed in FY 18, continues in future
- Expand Jr. High Program Continues to grow, moved out of Youth Room and into DeSales Hall
- Re-introduce Women Bible Study *Tuesday morning Bible Studies were comprised mostly of women, will continue to evaluate this program.*
- Expand Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) Sessions a Montessori Increased number of Level 2 and Tuesday afternoons - Continues next year with school possibilities and Level 3
- Social Justice Book Study Sr Janice organized in the Fall with no signups. Future plan to work with Fr. Dolan on this as part of the catechesis on Social Concerns under Outreach.
- Vacation Bible School-Summer 2018 Event planned, advertised and completed

### **Fellowship**

- Conduct a Parish Service Day Try again next year with Faith Formation and Outreach
- Ensure facilities are maintained properly. This includes buildings/grounds. *Major efforts accomplished with painting and repair more ground to cover Continues in the future*
- Internal space will be clean and clear from trash and storage items. Broken furniture needs to be identified and repaired.
   We have done an excellent job of this starting with Summer '17 Clean-up Tour, continues in the future
- Create an on-line scheduling system that Groups can request availability. **Actual on-line system delayed, pending Tech Council but integrated calendar well underway**
- Publish and circulate a facility use guide so all groups are held accountable to the same guidelines. Completed will be reviewed again for FY '9
- Create a community organization directory with leadership contact and gathering information. *Delayed, pending census returns for parishioner membership updates.*
- Create an online form for bulletin and website announcements. Completed and being used frequently
- Publish specific guidelines regarding priority of facility access. Completed will be reviewed again for FY 19
- Improve the options for "key" access to all facilities especially for after-hours activities. Underway for DeSales Hall and Preschool - next year review other key requirements



### Fellowship (continued)

- Foster an environment of collaboration and sharing of resources between the fellowship groups. Had great kick-off
  meeting, trying for FY 19 Planning meeting in early June
- Support community fellowship by capitalizing on all gatherings that bring everyone together. Completed with Fall Fest, Fish Fry and Summer Kick-off, as major examples and continues in future
- Increase staff Support and Presence with Parish Groups. Some groups have presence, others still need staff angel program
- Review all Fellowship Groups to determine their support of the values and visions of the community. Review Summer

- Create a shared Master Calendar that all members of the Community can access and understand. *Great progress by staff to prepare FY 19 calendar*
- Recognize the contributions of our Groups leaders and volunteer members Volunteer reception scheduled
- Prepare a plan for renovating or rebuilding St. Joseph's Center Facilities Committee meeting to occur in summer
