Our new Learning Management System, Schoology, will become the primary communication tool used to facilitate eLearning with our students who may not be able to join us on campus at any point. Students may move within the eLearning platform and the in-person instruction delivered as needed throughout the year. The students will follow the class schedule assigned to them at the beginning of the year and will participate in live streaming of classes when direct instruction is provided by a teacher through the use of the Schoology platform. When there is monitoring of independent work on campus our eLearning students will not be live in the classroom but will take that time to independently complete assignments at home as well.

What is Schoology?

Schoology is an online learning management system that allows teachers to create and manage courses for the students. Teachers can engage students, share content, manage lessons, and connect with students and families. It will streamline the process by which eLearning is delivered to our students and should make it easier for all involved to stay on top of assignments, due dates, and locate materials.

Benefits for using Schoology in our eLearning environment:

- Provides anywhere, anytime access through a web browser or mobile app regardless of device type
- Integrates external sites, games, tools, and other resources with the app center
- Create, organize, and distribute materials for each course that students can access in one platform
- Allows for easy communication with students and parents, can facilitate online classroom discussions
- Provides a calendar to manage assignments and activities
- Connects with PowerSchool to record grades and attendance
- Can create online assessments for use by students at school or at home
- Gives parents visibility into child's activities and progress
